GAB TITUI CULTURAL CENTRE TO UNDERGO RENOVATIONS IN 2015

The Torres Strait Regional Authority (TSRA) have confirmed that The Gab Titui Cultural Centre will remain open while minor renovations take place to the café and office areas later this month.

Renovations are set to begin in late October, however TSRA Chairperson, Mr Joseph Elu, said they will have minimal impact on the operations of the Centre.

“Gab Titui will continue to service the public during the period of works,” Mr Elu said.

“There may be some minor unexpected interruptions to services during this time, however we endeavour to keep the impact on the community to an absolute minimum.”

The renovations will provide improved conditions for on-site storage of artworks and cultural artefacts, and are expected to reach the completion date by mid-2016.

“As our art industry grows, it is important that Gab Titui, our region’s major exhibition space and keeping place, is able to safely accommodate the growing number of artworks and cultural artefacts,” Mr Elu said.

The Gab Titui Cultural Centre Café will also receive an upgrade, and will be closed for the full duration of works.

“We look forward to reopening the Gab Titui café in 2016 with full service to the community,” Mr Elu said.
