The kit covers:

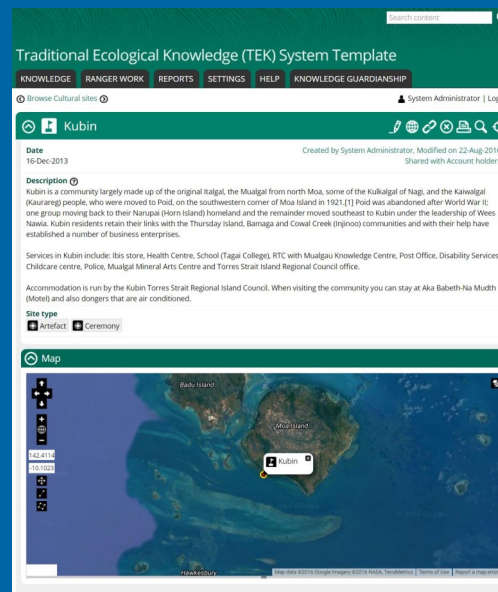
- How to apply to your RNTBC to collect/record TEK
