#### **What's on Offer**

The TSRA is offering Assistance with Tertiary Education Scheme (ATES) Scholarships to support Torres Strait Islander and Aboriginal people (of any age) to undertake study for their first undergraduate qualification at a tertiary institution, by providing financial assistance towards living and study-related expenses. The value of each scholarship is \$6,000\* per calendar year for full-time students.

\*Paid on a per-semester pro- rata basis.

#### **Eligibility**

### To be eligible to apply for an ATES scholarship you must be:

- Torres Strait Islander or Aboriginal and a resident of the **Torres Strait region**
- Studying your first undergraduate degree full-time
- Planning to study full-time on campus
- Motivated to undertake and be committed to the program of studies

#### For continuing students you must:

Have attained a minimum 'Pass' level for all subjects in the past semester.
